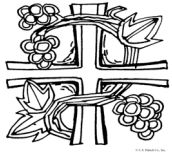
TODAY'S READINGS

the work of your hands.***

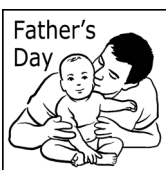
***Kindly protect all the fathers who trustingly

you and with Mary, his tender Mother.***

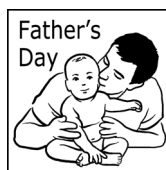
***Assure those you protect that they do not labor
