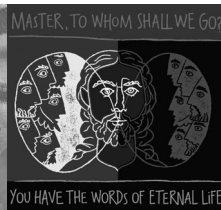
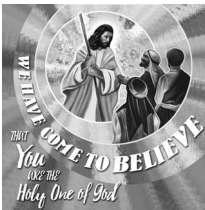

As of today, our total amount pledged is **\$51,678.**

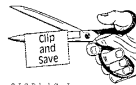


There will be no rosary or Divine Mercy during the summer, but will resume in September. Have a happy summer!
