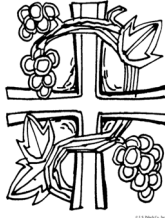

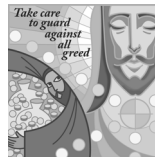

Still another family stops to pray for a son lost years ago, a son who graduated from our school. He is always remembered. Unsung heroes of our police department, some who died on September 11<sup>th</sup>, others in the line of duty protecting us, are remembered right here in our Garden. 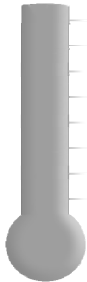
**Annual Catholic Appeal**

Please remember that every dollar over our goal comes back to Our Lady of Guadalupe Parish.

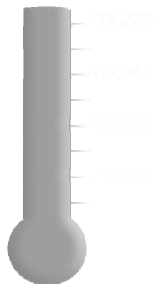


**Generations of Faith**
