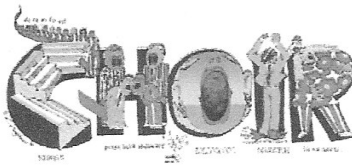

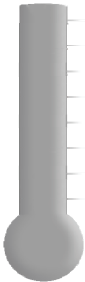
**Annual Catholic Appeal**

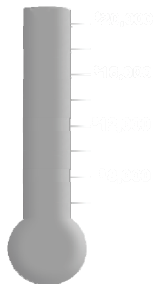
