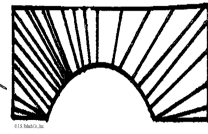

It is a lovely way to honor someone's memory, please stop by the rectory during office hours to purchase a gift.

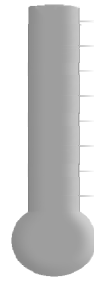
