## **A Letter from the Office of the Bishop**

October 21, 2020

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the visiting Missionaries who were invited to visit each parish in our Diocese this past summer were unable to come and make their appeal. These Missionary groups desperately need our help.

In an effort to help these Missionaries, I ask that every parish take up a mandatory second collection on the weekend of November 7/8, 2020.

The total amount collected by our Diocese will be evenly divided among the 42 different groups who had been invited to make their appeals. Checks for this collection should be made payable to the **Propagation of the Faith Office**, and sent to 310 Prospect Park West, Brooklyn, NY 11215.

For those parishes using GiveCentral as their electronic giving provider, this collection will be automatically added to your parish giving options as “Missionary Collection-Propagation of the Faith.” If you use a provider other than GiveCentral, please request this addition be made to your system by your provider. The parish should forward the total of these electronic gifts using a check as instructed above.

In addition, please promptly forward all second collections that were previously collected.
