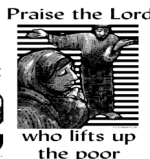

school year for children in grades K through 8.

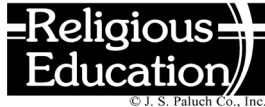
Our first day of classes will be on

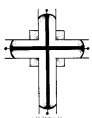

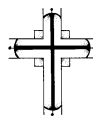
